He sacrifices his knife and ties it to a sapling to make another trap, which kills Ivan when he stumbles into it. Zaroff smokes a pipe by his fireplace, but two issues keep him from the peace of mind: the difficulty of replacing Ivan and the uncertainty of whether Rainsford perished in his dive.
